The name “Iguazu” comes from the Guarani or Tupi words, meaning “water”, and *ûasú*, meaning “big”. Legend has it that a god planned to marry a beautiful woman named *Naipi*, who fled with her mortal lover *Tarobá* in a canoe. In rage the god sliced the river, creating the waterfalls and condemning the lovers to an eternal fall. The first European to find the falls was the Spanish.

Macuco Safari

Walk 3 km by jeep through the jungle, with explanatory charts on the fauna, flora and native Indians. Walk in the jungle for about 600 meters and boat ride through the rapids of the river Iguazu, arriving literally underneath the falls. It's worth taking the time to this tour because it is the best and most complete existing on the Brazilian side of Iguazu Falls.

White water Rafting

Relax and enjoy the waters of the Iguassu River and its rapids on a thrilling adventure, rafting the Grand Canyon.

Bird Park

It's the best bird park in South America, where visitors have the opportunity to reach out and touch the beautiful native species, and exotic birds from all continents. Scenic flight over the Falls
